A couple of notes from the book *Rotary in Canada*, published in February, 1985.

Pg 53:

“There were no districts in Rotary until 1915 when, at the San Francisco Convention, districts were set up, and all of Western Canada was in the 18th District. The Calgary club had been organized in 1914. Vancouver and Victoria had been organized in 1913. At the Atlanta Convention, held in June 1917, the 18th District was extended east to take in the Port Arthur-Fort William Club, formed in 1916. Vancouver and Victoria were removed from the 18th District at this 1917 Convention, but not the rest of BC. At the Kansas City Convention, June 18th, the 18th District was changed to the 19th and was set up as Alberta-Saskatchewan-Manitoba and that part of Ontario west of the 85th meridian. At the Los Angeles Convention in 1922, the 19th District was changed to the 4th....”

“As Rotary developed in Western Canada District 19 was renumbered District 4 in 1922; D116 in 1937; D171 in 1950; then divided and finally re-numbered D555 and D536”

Final note:

Our district became D5550 in 1991 when RI re-numbered all districts to a four-number format.
